

## Marlette Regional Hospital Financial Assistance Policy (FAP) Eligible Health Care Services

Listed below are the services that are eligible for inclusion with the Marlette Regional Hospital Financial Assistance Policy (FAP):

1. Inpatient acute care services (including observation).
2. Inpatient swing bed services.
3. Emergency department services.
4. Physician office services for those clinics that are owned and operated by MRH.
5. Surgical services (including treatment room services).
6. Anesthesia services.
7. Lab services, including pathology.
8. Radiology services including: diagnostic imaging, ultrasound, nuclear medicine, CT scan, PET scan, mammography, interventional procedures, and bone density.
9. Cardiology services including: EKG, inhalation therapy, sleep studies, vascular studies, neurology, and cardiology.
10. Rehabilitation services including: physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech services.
11. Pharmacy services.
12. Diabetes education services.
13. Hospitalist physician services.
14. Emergency room physician services.
15. Self-administered drugs.
16. Infusion therapy, injections, and transfusions.
17. Ambulance services.

Services specifically excluded from coverage in the FAP include but are not limited to:

1. Hospice/Respite and parent care services.
2. Long-term care services.
3. Physician services from independent clinics and practices (not owned by MRH).
4. Seton Cancer Institute services. This is owned and operated by St. Mary's of Michigan.
5. Non-medically necessary procedures.
6. Non-covered procedures and services.
7. Hannah D. Wolfe Retirement Residence room and board fees.
8. Other types of services not typically covered by insurance carriers (i.e.: cosmetic, plastic surgery, and experimental procedures).
9. Non-patient care related services (i.e. medical records fees).
10. Vaccinations for children (VFC) program.
11. Occupational health contract services.
12. Physician reading and interpretation services.
