Eligible Services for the Financial Assistance Policy (FAP)

Listed below are the services that are eligible for inclusion with the Marlette Regional Hospital (MRH) Financial Assistance Policy (FAP):

1. Ambulance services.
2. Cardiology, including EKG, cardiology, inhalation therapy, sleep studies, vascular, and neurology.
3. Diabetic education services.
4. Emergency departments services.
5. Emergency room physician services.
6. Hospitalist physician services.
7. Infusion therapy, injections, and transfusions.
8. Inpatient acute care services (including observation).
9. Inpatient swing bed services.
10. Lab services (including pathology).
11. Pharmacy services.
12. Physician office services for those clinics that are owned and operated by MRH.
13. Radiology services, including diagnostic imaging, ultrasound, nuclear medicine, cat-scan, pet-scan, mammography, interventional procedures, and bone density.
14. Rehab services, including physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech services.
15. Self-administered drugs.
16. Surgical, including treatment room services and anesthesia services.
17. Wound care program.

Services specifically excluded from coverage in the FAP include, but are not limited to:

1. Hannah D. Wolfe Retirement Residence rent.
2. Hospice services.
3. Long-Term Care services.
4. Non-covered procedures and services.
5. Non-medically necessary procedures.
6. Non-patient services (such as medical records fees).
7. Occupational health contract services.
8. Other types of services not typically covered by insurance carriers (i.e.: cosmetic, plastic surgery, and experimental procedures).
9. Parent care services.
10. Physician reading and interpretation services.
11. Physician services from independent (non-MRH owned) physician practices.
12. Ascension St. Mary's Seton Cancer Institute services (owned and operated by Ascension).
13. Vaccinations for children (VFC) program.
